A Message from Our Founder and CEO

In 2020, God gave me a vision and a heart to continue the work I did as the Executive Director of the White House Opportunity and Revitalization Council (Opportunity Zones), while serving under former Secretary of HUD, Dr. Ben Carson. My 80 city tour through some of the most distressed communities in America highlighted the desperate need for revitalization. I witnessed the hopelessness that poverty, dilapidated neighborhoods, and deteriorating education produced. My heart yearned to provide solutions to restore hope, economic sustainability, and generational transformation.

After My Presidential appointment concluded, My Wife Robin and I began to formulate a plan that would utilize the various platforms God gave us to make a measurable difference. We founded CEOC in april of 2021. Blessed with a tremendously wise and diversified board of directors, We convened to set forth a vision and a strategy Launching our three missional pillars: economic development, mentorship, and sports. Our goal is to create long term sustainability and make a generational impact in the lives of those we have been called to serve.

CEOC designed and currently operates two after-school "Learning Labs" that serve children in K-5th grades with the purpose of improving reading proficiency while also promoting Christ-like character. In less than one year, we have served 35 students by providing 180+ supplemental reading hours at our prestonwood baptist church and new life community church locations. We have also introduced Bible memory verses and stories as part of the curriculum, and give good old fashioned, personal attention!



Additionally, we recently Launched our mentorship program, "First Down!" For nearly 25 years, I put on my cleats, shoulder pads and helmet and ran up, down and around football and track fields. God gave me the ability to run, and to do it fast! This took me to world track championships and NFL stadiums. The athletic success I was blessed to have also opened the doors to many other opportunities. And without a shadow of doubt - the mentors who led, challenged, redirected, and loved me along the way profoundly impacted that success. CEOC intends to continue that effort by helping student athletes realize and use their talents to live a life of significance on and off the field!

This is accomplished through "First Down's" training sessions like "Professional Etiquette," "Role vs Identity," and summer job shadowing.

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


THE PERCENTAGE OF LOW-INCOME
